  - i. Alyssa worked with Grants Department and John to complete the grant application and Grants was completing grant application
- d. AARP Tax-Aide appointments are fully booked and will conclude on 04/10/2025
- e. MySeniorCenter Status
  - Alyssa worked with IT to order a Dell All-in-One computer on 04/03/2025, using the Budget line of 53490-Other Supplies and Materials
  - ii. Once received, Department will have refresher training on how to use MySeniorCenter and Department will assign MySeniorCenter scan tags for current WHSC Members.
    - Once ready, the MySeniorCenter computer will be docked by the sign in/out and WHSC will schedule how to workshops for Members
      - a. Aiming to have MySeniorCenter software fully operable for July 1, 2025, for Annual Membership Fee renewal

- 6. Old Business
  - a. Donna's Destinations
    - Alyssa spoke to Donna and the cost associated with each Donna's Destination is calculated through cost of admission/ticket, coach transportation cost with gratuity added, specific trip happenings i.e. lunch, tour, etc.
      - 1. Dependent on which trip, there has been a profit from Donna's Destinations which the profit covers the costs for:
        - a. Trip giveaway items
          - i. i.e. each traveler to Foxwoods was given a small, casino themed tote filled with casino themed butter mints and \$5 coupon to Johnny Rockets
        - b. Trip raffles that include themed items

- i. i.e. La Gondola in 2024 had a raffle for the travelers to win a Yankee Candle that smelled like an Italian cannoli and wine
- c. Donna's Destinations promotional items that are either raffled off or bought from travelers to better promote
  - i. i.e. water bottle cozies, shirts, and canvas totes
- d. Compensated lunch for travelers for the smaller, short trips
  - Ex. Lost in New Haven travelers had a free pizza lunch at Brazi's, covered by the Donna's Destinations account.
- ii. At this time, there is not a statistic of the percentage of WHSC Members versus Non-WHSC Members and WH Residents versus Non-WH Residents that are utilizing the Donna's Destinations
  - 1. Will look to see if that would be possible to collect this type of statistical data once operating with MySeniorCenter
- b. Pricing for WHSC and Non-WHSC Members
  - The costs associated with Happenings Happening i.e. Veterinary Care Everywhere, are specific and controlled by whoever is hosting the event.
    - 1. Once closer to the move to Molloy school, may look to increase WHSC Membership Annual Fee.
- c. Adult Day Care Center's gift shop
  - Once closer to the move to Molly School, may look to create a gift shop or thrift shop as other Senior Centers have and operate successfully.
  - ii. The Adult Day Care Center's gift shop along with other rooms and WHSC are being sorted and cleaned out; spring cleaning set for April 21st-25th with a dumpster and shredding bins
- d. AED and Narcan training for residents
  - i. A Narcan training for residents has been scheduled by the West Haven Health Department on Wednesday April 9<sup>th</sup> at 6:30-7 PM at the West Haven Library
