A Special Meeting of the City of West Haven Fire Department Allingtown was held on Thursday, August 19, 2021 at City of West Haven Fire Department Allingtown, 20 Admiral Street, West Haven, CT - via zoom.

Present were Commissioners : Iris Diaz, Cori Nunley, Kevin Corcoran and Frederick Brown. Also present was Chief Michael Terenzio and Deputy Chief Esposito.

Commissioner Diaz called the meeting to order at 5:50 pm.

2. Roll Call

Roll was taken and a quorum was declared.

Chief Terenzio explained some of the criteria linked to the FEMA Grant of \$571,000 for the purchase of a new pumper. He was informed that there will not be any more extensions for the purchase of the apparatus. This was taken into consideration with this purchase. He explained the RFP (Request for Proposal) process. The RFPs were in on time which was August 12th by 4:30 pm. They are here at the Admiral Street station for view. They were from Marion/Spartan, Pierce Fire Apparatus, Smeal Fire Apparatus and Sutphen Fire Apparatus. Commissioner Brown did take some time to view them. Chief Terenzio explained that because we are having this meeting via zoom, I made a matrix with the important facts from each company that pertained to the decision of this purchase. The Deputy Chief and I were astounded at some of the quotes. There is a \$150,000 difference between the proposals. A discussion followed with some concerns. Commissioner Brown asked a few questions about the seating capacity of the truck and the warranty. Deputy Chief Esposito answered these questions diligently. A motion was made by Commissioner Corcoran to purchase the Smeal Fire Apparatus, seconded by Commissioner Nunley and approved unanimously.

A motion was presented to adjourn by Commissioner Nunley, seconded by Commissioner Brown and approved unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6:34 p.m.
